### **Can I download an Overdrive eBook for my Kindle?**

According to the device specifications for the Amazon Kindle, it does not currently support DRM protected PDF or EPUB (Adobe) or PRC (Mobipocket) files, the formats in which eBooks from OverDrive are delivered. The Kindle also does not currently support DRM protected WMA (Windows Media Audio) files, one of the formats in which OverDrive Audiobooks are delivered. OverDrive MP3 Audiobooks should, however, be able to be played on the Kindle. For more information, please see the [Kindle specifications](#).

### **What is DRM?**

DRM is Digital Rights Management, a term used to describe the access controls a publisher may put on digital content to prevent unauthorized distribution.

**Can I download to a library computer?**

Not at this time. To download an ebook or audiobook, you must have your own computer.

No, titles that you have checked out expire automatically so you never have to worry about turning them in on time.
