1) iCloud Backup	Summary
Settings > Your Name / Apple ID > iCloud > Manage Storage	Review your available iCloud storage space (upgrade, if needed)
Settings > Your Name / Apple ID > iCloud > iCloud Backup (turn on) > Back up Now Must connect device to power source, connect to WiFi, Lock your device's screen	 Turning on runs backup automatically Most common and convenient If over 5 Gigs, monthly cost for iCloud based on storage space required This option does stop the computer backup process with iTunes / Finder
2) Computer Backup	Summary
iTunes (OS 10.14 or earlier) Plug device into computer > Open iTunes > Click iPhone icon (top left) > Backups > Select "This Computer" Finder (OS 10.15 or later) Plug device into computer > Open Finder > Select Device from "Locations" on menu > Choose backup option > Back up Now	 You can backup your device onto your computer No monthly cost for online storage Requires a computer with significant storage space Requires time to upload Will no longer backup using iCloud Backup

Settings > General > iPhone/iPad Storage View Recommendations: Optimize Photos Offload Unused Apps Review Large Attachments	 Optimize Photos keeps originals oniCloud and keeps smaller file on device when low on space Save space by removing unused Apps You can delete large attachments from messages individually
