Get the most benefit by knowing your home screen options and basic settings

Home Screen

☐ Status Icons

View signal and battery status at the top of the screen.



■ Moving/Deleting Apps

Organize your home screen and remove unwanted apps. (Hold down on empty space until apps wobble > move app icon to desired location > touch minus sign to remove or delete unwanted apps > touch Done)



□ App Dock

Place your most popular apps onto the dock at the bottom of the screen. (Hold down on empty space on home screen > move app icons off/on dock area)



Creating App Folders

Organize your home screen by grouping apps into folders. (Hold down on app icon > drag icon over the top of another app you wish to make a folder with)



□ App Library

View all your apps in the app library. (Swipe from right to left until you reach the end of the home screen)



□ App Switcher

Quickly navigate between multiple open apps. (Swipe up slowly from the very bottom right of screen > Scroll and choose the app you wish to use)



□ Search

Search your device or the Internet from the general search bar. (Pull down from any empty space on home screen > type or speak your keyword search)






