RE: Libraries Facilities Financing Authority Budgets for 2025-26

RECOMMENDATION

Approve adjustment to Libraries Facilities Financing Authority (LFFA) Proposed 2025-26 General Fund budget to increase Debt Service payments, increase the distributions to members, and adopt the attached budgets as amended.

DISCUSSION

Proposed budgets were presented to the board on April 3. Since preparation of the proposed budget, each member's board approved an increase to the Maximum Distribution Amount of \$30,000,000, from \$77,500,000 to \$107,500,000. The LFFA also issued bonds in the amount of \$18,680,000 plus a net premium of \$678,282 for total proceeds of \$19,358,282. The estimated actual amounts have been adjusted to reflect the bond issuance. The proposed budget has been adjusted to reflect increases in debt service resulting from the debt issuance and member distributions have been increased to reflect the revised maximum distribution amounts.

The adjusted General Fund and Debt Service Fund Budgets are presented here for final adoption. The attached Final Budgets reflect the anticipated Sources and Uses of LFFA funds.

Allocation of Special Tax in the 2025-26 budget has been amended based on the revised maximum distribution amounts in the percentages reflected below.
