

Draft Downtown Library Program Accomplishments as of September 28, 2017

- Increases children's space by 2,000 s.f. including a children's program space (6,000 s.f.)
- Adds a teen room (1,300 s.f.)
- Maintains collections size
- Provides abundant comfortable seating (from 189 to 268 spots)
- Creates a 2,000 s.f., dividable programming room (from 88 to 125 seats)
- Adds 8 small group study rooms
- Includes 69 public computer stations
- Adds a computer lab and creation space/media lab
- Maintains a joint genealogy/local history area
- Contemplates two-dimensional art
- Includes vending but not a cafe
- Moves out system administrative spaces and incorporates all Downtown branch staff
- Moves 4,400 s.f. of storage/staff space to public services
- Brings building infrastructure to code, including ADA disability and green building standards
